

## First Study **Seeking God**

**Question:** “What is your view of God at this point in your life”?

### **God came down to us through Jesus!**

**John 1:1-18** Key Points:

**Verse 1** – Jesus is called the Word; he was with God the Father, and himself was God.

**Verse 14** – The Word became a man, but a unique man who was also God.

**Verse 18** – Jesus came to reveal God to us, to show us what God is really like.

### **God desires a relationship with us through Jesus**

**John 3:16-17** God wants us to know Him. He has a plan for your life!

### **God is able to be found!**

**Mt. 7:7-8** This is a great promise! God is a loving Father, and he wants you to find him.

If you seek him, he will be found. *What should I be doing?*

### **Be sure you are on the right path**

**Mt. 7:13-14** The road to life is narrow and many miss it. A true seeker will find it. Find that path and stay on it.

### **Seeking God should be my top priority**

**Mt. 6:33** The only effective way to seek God is to seek God first.

*What does that mean?*

### **What does that look like?**

**Acts 8: 26-39** The Ethiopian was a great example of someone “seeking first.” He sought out the scriptures. He was humble and asked for help. When he found the truth, he held on to it. **Make it your goal to be this kind of seeker.**

**Assignment:** Begin reading the book of John. Seek knowledge and a relationship with God through Jesus.
