What is Bible Quest?

Bible Quest is a journey to gain a deeper understanding and appreciation for God’s Word and to get a sense of the “Big Picture.” By working in small groups and then coming together to share and illustrate findings, the group as a whole will see things in the Scriptures they may never have considered before.

The Quest will start with Bible Study and note-taking and then end up with a video presentation bringing it all together.

How Does it Work?

Based on the size of the overall group, small teams are formed to take on portions of the Bible. It can be broken down any number of ways, but for this first attempt, we are organizing teams of 4-5 as follows:

- Pentateuch
- Historical Books
- Prophets
- Gospels

Each group then has the same 5 themes to look for:

- Messianic Prophecies
- God’s Character
- God’s Promises
- God’s People
- God’s Plan of Salvation

What is the Plan?

Bible Quest Scholars will be assigned reading each week along with several target Scriptures to help them get started in find information about the themes within their section.

Bible Quest Scholars are also given some key information to gather for the themes so that all groups are consistent:

1. Scripture Reference
2. Approximate Dates
3. Several sentences around what was discovered about the theme
4. Any Interesting 'factoids' related to the topic

Each team is given a 5-section notebook, one for each theme in which to collect their notes.

Each week in Sunday class, we will talk about our findings and what the next week assignment is.

The Video

As we start nearing the end of our study, we will go back through the gathered material and start organizing it by themes. The Scholars will help come up with questions based on what they have found so that they can then answer those questions on video as the Bible Quest Scholars they have become! The result will be like a feature on the History Channel and will be something for them to be proud of and fondly remember over the years while establishing some great Bible study habits.
